- 2. **2 x Self-billing agreements**: All Openfield sub-contracted transport is self-billed. We need your written acceptance of this for VAT purposes.
- 3. BACS Payment Authorisation
- 4. Copy of TASCC certificate
- 5. Copy of O-License
- 6. Copy of Motor Insurance
- 7. Copy of Goods in Transit Insurance
